

COVID-safe Studio Policies for Students and their Family Attending In-Studio Classes

- Each in-studio class is strictly limited to a maximum of 4 families.
- Only 1 adult is allowed to attend classes with each of their enrolled child, and therefore allowed to enter the My Musical Adventure studio. This is to adhere to the 4 square metres of space per person rule.
- Non-enrolled siblings are not allowed to attend the classroom or wait inside our studio.
- Students and their accompanying adult must stay home and not attend our studio if either or both of them are sick, or have any symptoms of flu or cold.
- Our teacher and staff on-site will require you to immediately leave the class and the studio if the students and/or their accompanying adult present any symptoms of flu or cold.
- Students and their accompanying adult must stay home and not attend our studio if they are awaiting COVID test results.
- Students and their accompanying adult must self-isolate at home for 14 days and not attend our studio if they have just returned from overseas travel.
- You must advise My Musical Adventure immediately if the student and/or their accompanying adult are confirmed as having COVID-19, or are a close contact with someone who is.
- From 2020 Term 3, our makeup policy will allow you to make up any missed lessons by the end of 2020, provided you advise us prior to your scheduled lesson that you are not well to attend lessons. However, if you are sent home by our teacher then you will not be entitled to a makeup lesson.
- Due to the limited number of students we can accept for each class, priority will be given to students who are entitled to makeup lessons due to sickness for any vacant class spot.
- You should report to Kathleen, the Director of My Musical Adventure via email on kathleen@mymusicaladventure.com.au, or call on 0403 452 238 if you suspect the teacher in attendance is sick or displays flu-like symptoms.
- Students and their accompanying adult must wash their hands with hand sanitiser when entering and leaving our studio.
- Students and their accompanying adult must practise good hygiene while they are present at our studio, e.g. cough/sneeze into their elbow or a clean tissue.
- Please clean up your child's accidental spillage or saliva with disinfectant wipes.
- To minimise the spread of virus and germs, please take your used tissues and rubbish etc. with you when you leave our studio.
- Students and their accompanying adult should maintain 1.5 metres between themselves and other adults when they are present at our studio. Appropriate sitting spots will be marked on the floor in the activity area. Please direct your child to sit on those marked spots as best they can during the lesson.
- We ask for your cooperation by cleaning the immediate areas around your sitting spot with the disinfectant wipes provided at the end of your lesson.
- Please minimise time spent in our studio and not to congregate in groups. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
- Please dress appropriately as we will leave studio windows open to allow for more ventilation.
- In the event that in-person lessons have to stop due to government mandated lock down, classes will continue online. No refunds will be provided if you choose not to attend the remaining online lessons.
